WHERE WE SERVE

Zacapa, Guatemala

While we serve all over the country of Guatemala, we focus on the state of Zacapa. For our home-building projects, we have chosen to focus on the town of Pueblo Modelo.

The government established the town of Pueblo Modelo after Hurricane Mitch in 1999. In a rush to relocate families affected by the hurricane, the city was established without any infrastructure (i.e., running water, electricity, etc.). Presently, Pueblo Modelo is one of the most impoverished towns in the State of Zacapa.



WHERE WILL WE STAY?

For groups under thirty people, the group will stay in the Hearts In Motion House located in Teculutan for the service portion of the trip.

For groups over thirty, the group will stay at the Hotel Atlantico for the service portion of the trip.

Both locations have hotel rooms with their bathroom, a pool to cool off after a hard day's work, and a dining room where the group will eat breakfast and dinner each day.

Regardless of group size, the entire group will stay in the same hotel while in Antigua at the end of the trip.



TRIP COST

We will work directly with your group to determine what length of trip will work best to suite your needs. The most typical trip lengths and costs can be found below.

10-Day Mission Trip- \$1250/person plus a plane ticket9-Day Mission Trip- \$1150/person plus a plane ticket8-Day Trip- \$1050/person plus a plane ticket



WHAT'S INCLUDED?

The trip fee covers almost all expenses while on the trip, including:

- Meals and beverages while in Zacapa
- All dinners while in Antigua
- Lodging for the entire trip
- All transportation while in Guatemala

- Morning/Evening Prayer and Processing (if desired)
- Emergency Medical Insurance
- Dedicated staff person to work directly with your group leader

What is not included in the trip fees:
